Minnesota: The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) Annual Eligibility Form United States Department of Agriculture (USDA)

Are you eligible? Below are the guidelines for income eligibility in order to receive TEFAP food that is handed out at the mobile pantries as well as the food shelves. Please take a look and make sure you are within the income guidelines or that you are on one of the programs below. No income verification is necessary.

I am eligible to receive TEFAP commodity food because I am in Minnesota and because my household income is 300% or less of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Eligibility is granted to all persons in situations of emergency and distress due to disasters. I am also eligible if I receive or participate in the following services and programs:
